Executive Committee: Members at Large

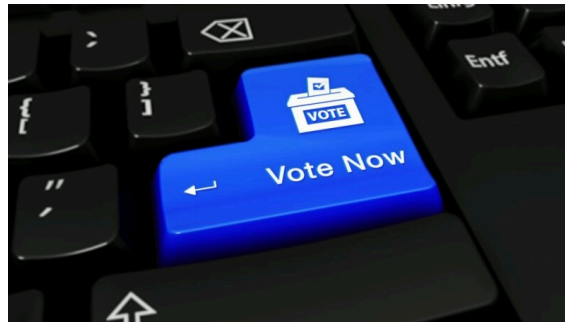
Nominations for Members at Large are now closed.

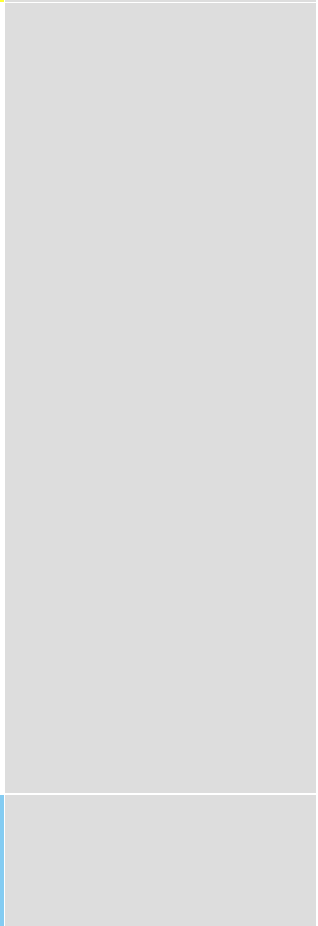
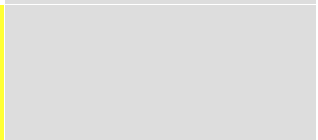
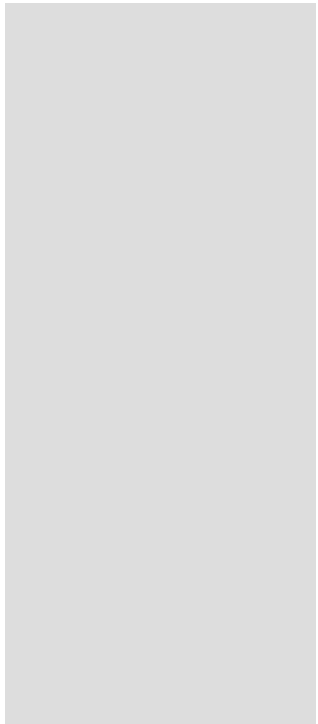

Having successfully passed the virtual heats, representatives from **SMURD Cluj** (Romania), **Faculty of Medicine of the University of Porto** (Portugal), **Mohammed Bin Rashid University of Medicine and Health Sciences** (UAE), **Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences** (Netherlands) and **Third Faculty of Medicine, Charles University** (Czech Republic) will attend the final stages of Sim University at #SESAM2024 in Prague.

Sim Uni is an opportunity for interprofessional teams of undergraduate healthcare students to compete against each other by taking part in simulation scenarios. Scenarios mirror basic emergency situations (resuscitation, anaphylaxis, myocardial infarction) reflecting the students' level of knowledge/ skills.

After each scenario, students are debriefed by expert facilitators, with a focus on promoting non-technical skills such as leadership, situational awareness, decision making, communication, and assertiveness, in addition to clinical reasoning within a team.
